FAQs

Who can book tickets for this tour?

We welcome anyone over the age of 18 to join us! Solo travellers, pairs/couples, smaller groups, parents & (adult) children...any combination is welcome. Just flag to us at the time of booking who you would like to share your room with.

How many people will be on this tour?

This is a small group tour, with no more than 12 travellers including the host(s).

What if I'm a solo traveller?

Our Explore events are perfect for solo travellers! We have designed the tour for all (solo travellers, pairs or small groups) in mind, ensuring that you can participate in all activities and feel comfortable doing so. At our core, we are all about making new friendships and sharing passions, so we will help foster meaningful conversations and fun experiences among the group. For accommodation arrangements, you will be paired with another solo traveller for the duration of the tour.

There is no single supplement for any solo travellers.

Who leads this tour?

Sophie, our founder, will be the lead host on this tour! She will be joined by a fellow literature-lover from Novel Bound Events and our driver, who is our local expert! Specialist guides will also lead portions of the tour, so you will be getting authentic and enthusiastic expertise specific to the area we are in or theme we are focusing on.

What does the "theme" of a tour mean?

The theme of any Explore tour is essentially the inspiration for the locations we visit, the activities and workshops we take part in, and the book we base our book club discussion around. Once you're signed up, you will receive a Welcome Pack which will include some book suggestions to help build up the excitement!

What is the theme for this tour?

In Ireland it only makes sense to focus on folklore, legends, and fairy tales! However, a general love of literature is at the core of every tour.

FAQs

What book has been selected for the book club during the tour?

No book has been selected yet! We make a decision as a group a few weeks prior to the tour.

Do we get to meet each other before the tour starts?

Yes...sort of! We will host a WhatsApp chat for group members, and a live-video call before we had off on our adventure! Here you can ask questions, share packing tips, and even begin discussing your favourite books in the lead up to the tour.

Do I need to read or prepare anything for this trip?

You don't "need" to read anything! We will send some recommendations your way, based on the tour's theme, but it's not "homework" and there is no prior knowledge or experience required. We would advise you to start reading the book club book before you arrive, so that we can have some discussions at our book club meal!

Do I need travel insurance?

Yes. You, as the traveller, are responsible for this. Please independently purchase travel insurance to cover any trip cancellation or delay, and medical treatment. Please read our T&C's for further information.

Are you insured?

Yes, we hold public liability insurance in the UK and Ireland.

Are tickets refundable?

All deposits are non refundable.

Cancellation by Customer: More than 90 days before departure: You may cancel your booking and receive a refund of any payments made, less the non-refundable deposit. 89 to 29 days before departure: You will receive a refund of 50% of the total tour price. Less than 28 days before departure: No refunds will be issued.

Cancellation by Company: If we cancel the Tour for any reason other than Force Majeure, you will receive a full refund of all payments made.

Can I order tickets for someone else? Can I make a group booking?

What does 'or similar' mean in reference to activities and accommodation on the inclusions page?

What is the activity/fitness level required for this tour?

Terms and Conditions for Payments

1. Introduction

These Terms and Conditions ("Terms") govern the payment policies for the small group tours ("Tour") provided by Novel Bound Events Ltd ("Company," "we," "us," "our"). By booking a Tour with us, you ("Customer," "you," "your") agree to be bound by these Terms.

2. Booking and Payment

- **2.1 Deposit:** To secure a place on the Tour, a non-refundable deposit of GBP 500.00 is required at the time of booking.
- **2.2 Final Payment:** The remaining balance must be paid in full no later than 28 days before the departure date of the Tour.
- **2.3 Late Bookings:** For bookings made within 28days of the departure date, full payment is required at the time of booking.
 - **2.4 Payment Methods:** We accept payments via debit card, credit card and PayPal, etc..

 All payments must be made in GBP.

3. Cancellations and Refunds

- 3.1 Cancellation by Customer: More than 90 days before departure: You may cancel your booking and receive a refund of any payments made, less the non-refundable deposit.
 89 to 29 days before departure: You will receive a refund of 50% of the total tour price.
 Less than 28 days before departure: No refunds will be issued.
 - **3.2 Cancellation by Company:** If we cancel the Tour for any reason other than Force Majeure, you will receive a full refund of all payments made.
- **3.3 Force Majeure:** In the event of cancellation due to circumstances beyond our control (e.g., natural disasters, pandemics, political instability), we will offer a full refund or reschedule the Tour at no additional cost.
